

# Be aware of signs of exploitation and human trafficking

Millions of people are fleeing from Ukraine, and some criminal groups or individuals may try to take advantage of the situation. You can meet individuals who seem helpful but who want to exploit you.

**Keep this in mind when someone offers to arrange travel, accommodation or work for you:**

- ! **Take pictures of ID-documents and license plates** of the people who offer to help. **Send them to someone you trust**
- ! **Do not hand over your personal documents** or items to private persons. Personal documents include ID or passport, your phone etc.
- ! **Contact the Danish authorities to register**, even if you are privately accommodated. You can contact any authority and the police and they can direct you to the Danish Immigration Authorities. Call the Danish police at 114

- ! Be alert if someone tries to **recruit you for a job through social media or apps** (for example Telegram), where the job offer seems too good to be true
- ! You are **entitled to a salary** if you work in Denmark. Do not accept offers to work in exchange for somewhere to live, food or other goods. Make sure that the terms are acceptable and make sure to get a contract. Check the website [workplacedenmark.dk](http://workplacedenmark.dk)
- ! If someone offers you a job in prostitution, be aware that **it is illegal for him or her to earn money of your prostitution**

- ! You might have **several rights** as a Ukrainian citizen or as a person with refugee status in Ukraine. Read more about how to apply for a residence permit and other options: [nyidanmark.dk/ukraine](http://nyidanmark.dk/ukraine)
